

Fitzpatrick Launches New Book

ARTIST of the Light author and frequent visitor to the U.S. Roisin Fitzpatrick launched her new book, Taking Heaven Lightly, on January 20 at the Westbury Hotel in Dublin in front of an audience that included U.S. Ambassador to Ireland Kevin O'Malley; Niall Burgess, former Irish consul general in New York and currently the secretary general of the Irish Department of Foreign Affairs; *Riverdance* composer Bill Whelan; and golfer Christy O'Connor.

In her new book, Fitzpatrick takes the reader on her remarkable journey when in 2004, without any warning, she suffered a life-threatening brain hemorrhage. While in the ICU of Dublin's Beaumont Hospital, she felt herself being drawn out of her body and enveloped in a radiant light. There, in a blissful vision of the afterlife, she experienced the most extraordinary transformation of her life. Her discovery that heaven lies within each of us, that we are pure love and always at one with the eternal light, changed the course of her world.

Fitzpatrick went on to make a full recovery by integrating this newfound

understanding into her daily existence.
